

STATEMENT OF INTEREST

The awesome natural environment in Coachella Valley sparks my paintings. I go for walks to marvel at the light coming through leaves, brilliant hues of flowers, and jagged mountains in the distance. These natural elements connect me to an ethereal world greater than my physical being. I paint abstractions of these colors as rays and shapes to try and harness that joyful, vibrant energy.

I'd like to paint a bench in the Cathedral City Park specifically because it is a public park for all people to connect with the great outdoors and each other. I was fortunate to put my painting on a bus stop bench in Gary, Indiana 7 years ago, through the Legacy Foundation. It is wonderful to make art that people experience during their day. I believe it connects us in a positive way.

I make my paintings by first hand-brush-stroking a rainbow of acrylic paint colors on the surface. Next, I cut and apply sticker masks to block out the spectrum of colors. Finally, I spray paint layers of various transparencies on top. For me, mixing traditional painting techniques with the "street art" medium of spray paint feels inclusive of a range of styles. After removing the masked stickers, the rainbows show through like another layer beyond the material world.
