A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CATHEDRAL CITY, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING HOLIDAYS ON WHICH CITY OF CATHEDRAL CITY PUBLIC OFFICES SHALL BE CLOSED FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025

WHEREAS Section 6700 of the California Government Code designates days that are holidays in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Section 6702 of the California Government Code provides that City offices shall be closed on designated State holidays unless otherwise provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires and deems it to be in the public's best interest to designate those holidays on which the City of Cathedral City public offices will be closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CATHEDRAL CITY, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

The City Council hereby finds the recitals set forth above to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT CITY OF CATHEDRAL HOLIDAYS

- A. The public offices of the City of Cathedral City shall be closed on the dates set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution and incorporated by this reference.
- B. Holidays falling on Saturday will be observed on the preceding Friday.
- C. Holidays falling on Sunday will be observed the following Monday.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect on December 31, 2024.

SECTION 4. CERTIFICATION

The City Clerk shall attest to and certify the vote adopting this Resolution.
