Statement of Interest

I am a full-time, professional fine artist living and working in Cathedral City. I am excited to be considered for a public works project so close to my own home. Cathedral City is a diverse and vibrant community, and our parks are full of life and fun. I would love to honor and celebrate that with my art.

My specialty is in wildlife art with a twist. That twist is often a gentle and fun version of Surrealism. For this project, I want a vibrant blue bench, festooned with floating poppies that are nourished by their own water source—a droplet at the end of each stem. On the top of the bench, everyone's favorite desert bird, the roadrunner, will be painted in full stride.

While most of my work to date is studio or gallery work, I do have experience with public art. My favorite public project I participated in was the Rabbitville fiberglass rabbit project in the Gaslamp District of San Diego. My rabbit was one of an eclectic group of painted sculptures that were approximately 4 feet tall at the ears. Much of my studio/gallery paintings are also of size. In recent years, I completed an 8 foot long cheetah painting, and I have a whole series of paintings that are 3x3 feet. The largest paintings I ever created were 11x17 feet, and they were a series of three! All of this is to illustrate that I am fully capable of completing larger works on a timeline.
