Title: Presentation on Animal Services from Representatives from the Coachella Valley Animal Campus

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

The Coachella Valley Animal Campus Commission is a board made up of members from Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs, Indian Wells, Indio, La Quinta, Palm Desert, and Rancho Mirage, along with a County of Riverside representative.

The board aims to coordinate and provide animal services for the unincorporated areas of Riverside County and the cities mentioned above, except for Desert Hot Springs, Palm Springs, and Rancho Mirage, which have their own animal control officers.

The Coachella Valley City/County Animal Shelter provides shelter and adoption services. Riverside County Animal Services handles field services for county areas and the cities mentioned above, except for the three that have their own officers.
