### **BACKGROUND:**

The terms of appointments and term limits for Commissions and Committees have been established in the Cathedral City Municipal Code. All members of the Commissions shall be appointed for a three-year term unless otherwise provided by law, Ordinance, Resolution or if not applicable.

**DISCUSSION:**

Staff posted a notice of the upcoming Commission/Committee terms expiring on June 30, 2024, at the Cathedral City Senior Center, Library and City Hall. The notice was also posted on social media and the City's website. Applications were accepted through close of business on May 31, 2024. Applications received were provided to the appropriate nominating Councilmembers for their review and nomination consideration.
